

#### CENTRAL JAIL VISIT 2018

#### 2. Objectives of the Practice

- 1. Students to have the opportunity to visit a correctional facility to dispel any myths that have been created or fostered by the media.
- 2. The visit adds that real world experience is different to what we talk about in the classroom.
- 3. To study the role of jail in treatment of offenders in the framework of rehabilitative and reformative activities given to the prisoners.
- 4. To study the infrastructure provided by jail authorities.
- 5. To study the behaviour of inmates.
- 6. To study the opportunities provided to inmates by jail authorities
- 7. To study the security system of jail premises.

#### 3. The Context

The tour to Central Jail Bhopal is conducted by the law department. The law students are headed by their teachers. It was an altogether different experience for law students of Faculty of Law, RKDF University Bhopal when they visited the Central Jail at Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh. The protocol officer of Central jail addressed the students and introduced them to the functioning of the Jail.

#### 4. The Practice

The tour is organized by law department especially for law students to have practical exposure of the working of the central jail and how the prisoners live there. They learn how the jail operates, what facilities are provided to inmates, their behavioral patterns, etc. Some of the major problems which are being faced by the students and institution can be summed up as follows:

- Lack of participation of the students. The students are failing to take advantage of the
  privilege of knowing the working of government. They lack interest and dedication. The
  students are unaware of the events happening in their universities and even if they are
  aware, they are not interested in participating in the event.
- Lack of appropriate funds, disinterest in guiding the students and helping the students when required is a major problem in some institutions.
- Sometimes the officials are not cooperative during the tour. They don't provide complete
  knowledge about the place which acts as a disadvantage on the student's part as these
  places are not visited by students on a regular basis. So all the queries of students must be
  attended.
- Some students feel very nervous, very uncomfortable. You could see it on their faces, and some of them said it. It is a very uncomfortable experience going in and seeing people who are serving time. Some of the people serving time are not happy that you are there for a tour; this definitely adds to the level of discomfort.


