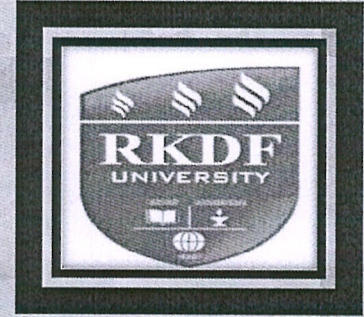

SEMINAR REPORT ON E-COMMERCE & CYBER SECURITY CHALLENGES IN DIGITAL INDIA

Date – 26th September 2018

Speaker - MR. PRASHANT TIWARI, APPIN TECHNOLOGY LAB, BHOPAL

Lack of awareness and cyber hygiene: Many users may not be fully aware of the potential cyber security risks involved in e-commerce transactions. Educating users about best practices,



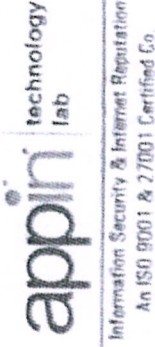
such as creating strong passwords, avoiding suspicious links, and keeping software up to date, can help enhance cyber hygiene.

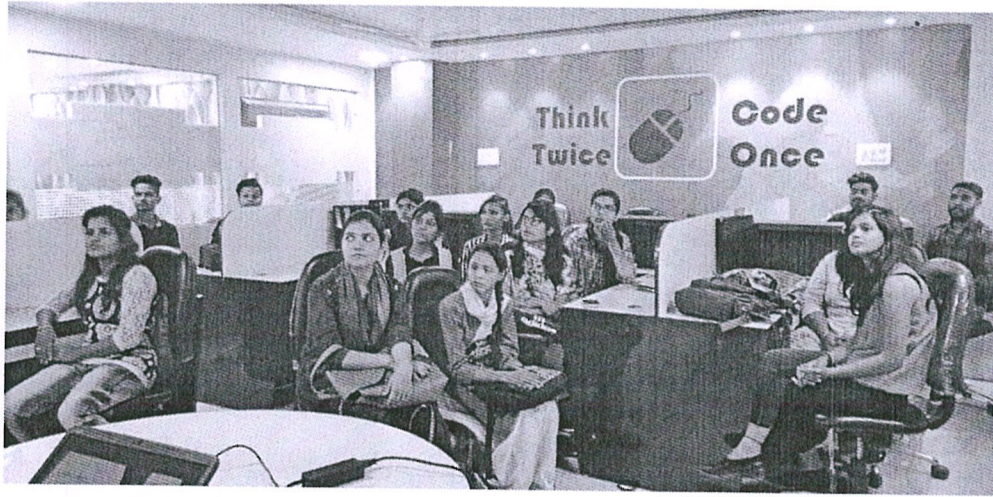





- College festivals are one of the first arenas for students where they are put together from various streams and asked to manage a large event. This taste of a real-world experience can build a variety of skills and be the perfect tool for practical learning.

3. The Context

The event MEGAMINDSS received huge number of participants across nation. The event had various categories for participation which included RKDF's First national level Mock Parliament in collaboration with Siyasat Welfare Foundation, Asian Style Parliamentary debate, Quiz, Debate, Extempore, Slogan Writing, Photography, where the winners from the RKDF 's First Mock Parliament received Rs. 2500/- cash prize, a trophy, certificate for being the best delegate and the high commendation award winner lifted rs. 1500/-cash prize along with a trophy and a certificate. In MegaMindss 2018, under Asian Style Parliamentary Debate, the winning team from Indore Institute of law, bagged the cash prize of Rs. 3000/- along with a trophy and a certificate.

Initially, the event was promoted through flex, flyer to various educational institutions of cities in MP naming, Indore, Ujjain, Jabalpur ,Sagar, Bina, Vidisha, Hoshangabad, Sehore, and Misrod. On a later phase, the electronic mode of promotion was also introduced like creation of page on RKDF's official website, updation of post on Facebook, Instagram and Law octopus. 1. Title of the Practice

LEGAL AID CAMP 2019

2. Objectives of the Practice

Legal Aid Clinics basically serve the purpose of providing legal advice not for the aim of earning profit but in General Public Interest. In law schools, though knowledge of law is thoroughly imparted. However theoretical knowledge is not sufficient when its applicability is not known. Students pursuing law have zeal and enthusiasm to provide legal services. Legal aid clinics thus serve the two-fold purpose, the first that they provide free legal services to economically weaker people and second, they direct the energies of the students of law in contributing to the society.

3. The Context

The legal aid camps are conducted by the law department. The law students are headed by their teachers. The members of the Legal Aid clinic are engaged in spreading legal awareness in rural areas through street plays as well as legal aid camps where they make the target population aware of different legal service programs and guide them to avail these facilities. The camp is being organized with an intention to provide legal aid and services to rural people who are unaware of their legal rights.

4. The Practice

The practice of organizing legal aid camps is implemented by all Universities/ colleges imparting laws courses. It is a part of curriculum of law students. The event is organized with an intention to provide practical knowledge to students, boosting their confidence in dealing with public and providing legal aid services to the poor and uneducated population of targeted rural area who are unaware of their legal rights. 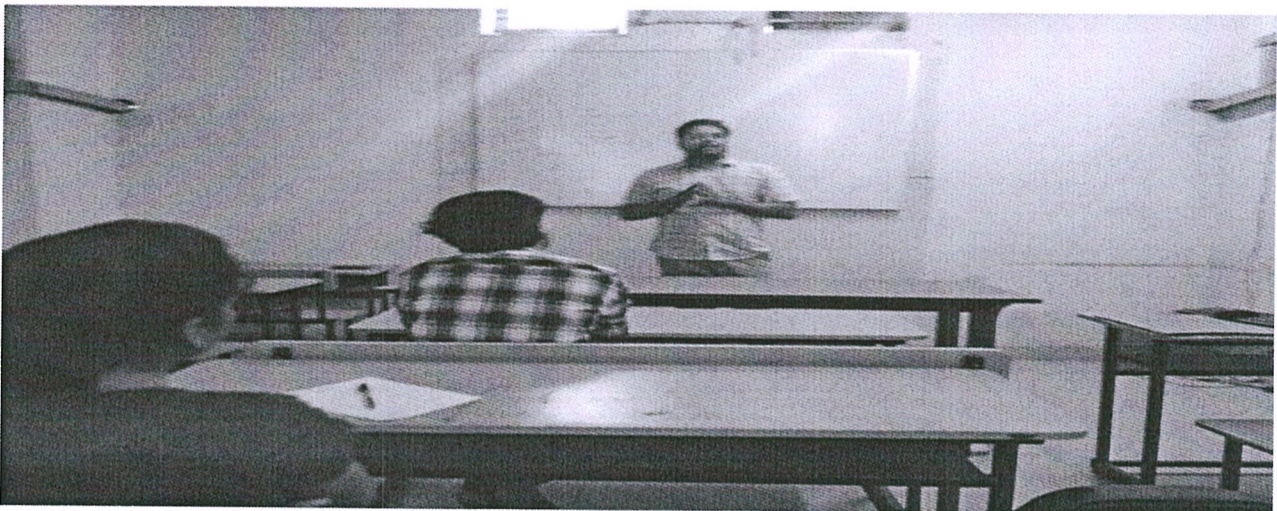


BSNL campus is visited by the students as shown in figure below where they have seen transmission section, Switching section and Power plant area. Further how the technical faults are solved are presented with the students.

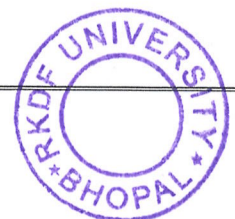

(iii) Technological know how about various exchanges used by BSNL is given.

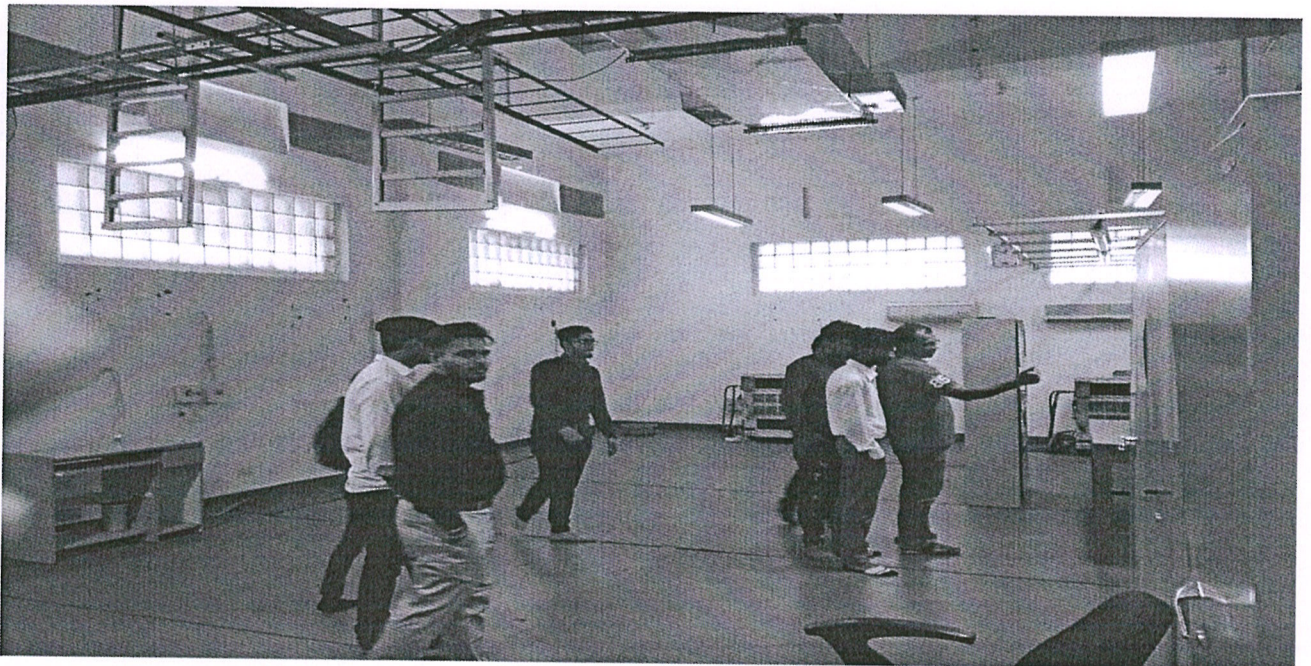


Various telecom switches used in BSNL and its working are described to the students .Live demonstrations about the switches is given as shown in the figures below.



(iv) Customer care section was shown and how the customer complaints are solved is shown.

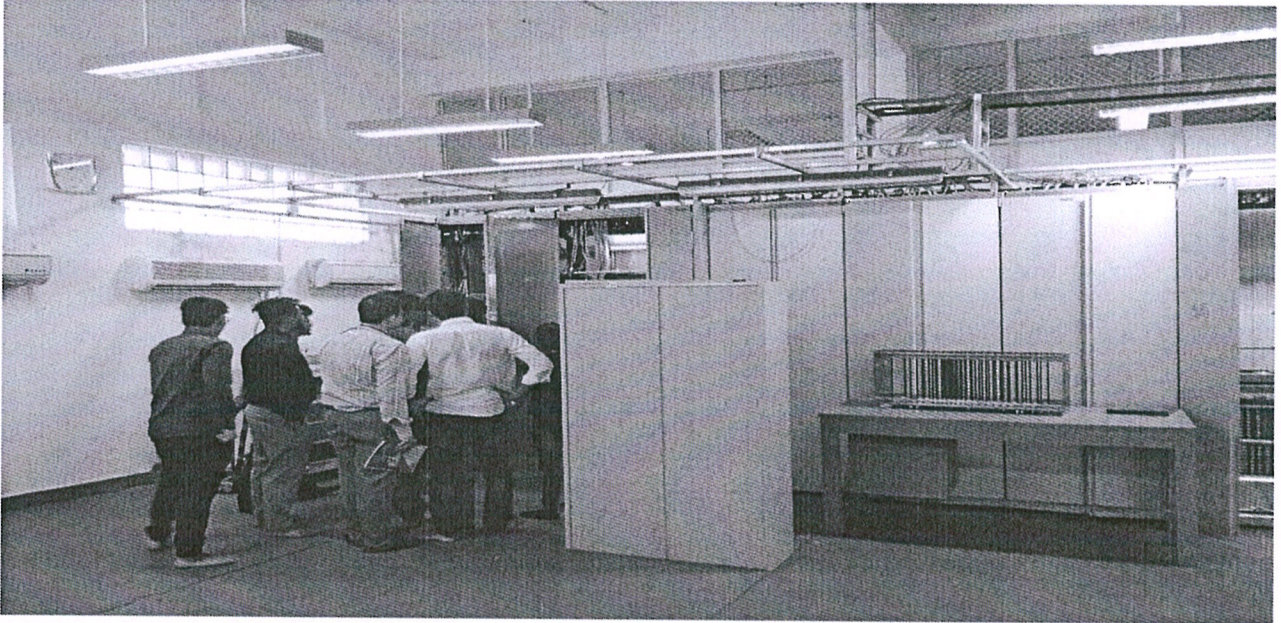
